APPROVED MINUTES FOR SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING MAPLE, WISCONSIN

Friday, September 8, 2023

The Special Town Board meeting for the Town of Maple was called to order by Chairman Dustin Soyring at 4:00 pm at the Maple Community Center.

ROLL CALL

Chairman Dustin Soyring, Supervisor Jon TePoel, Supervisor Thad Lintula, Clerk Rachel Lintula, and Fire Chief Mike Lundeen were in attendance

There being a quorum present, the meeting was in order.

NEW BUSINESS

1. Review and vote to disallow claims of Joseph Brunner against the Town of Maple.

Discussion included the fact that the road had been posted as closed since April 15th - nearly a month and half - before the accident occurred on May 23, 2023. In addition, the road was flagged as closed, and cones and flags were put up, but often stolen. Foreman Colby checked the road and its signage multiple times per week, replacing cones and flags as needed; he also contacted local law enforcement to request additional surveillance to prevent road use. The board also observed that no crash report was filed with the county, as required by law.

Rural Mutual Insurance Agency advised the town to vote to disallow Brunner's claim against the town.

MOTION by Chairman Soyring to vote to disallow claims of Joseph Brunner against the Town of Maple; motion seconded by TePoel and carried unanimously.

2. Review and discuss Fall Festival plans at the town park on September 23, 2023.

Discussion centered on sprucing up the park - power-washing the bathrooms, getting the new doors installed, and other park updates. Lundeen noted that it might be worth reaching out to Tiger Manufacturing to have the group spearhead a new sign for the park.

The day will include hayrides, games, and a barn dance to be held in the pavilion from 2-4. The festival runs from 1-6PM, with a movie in the park to follow at dusk.
