# APPROVED MINUTES FOR TOWN BOARD MEETING MAPLE, WI

Thursday, November 9, 2023

The monthly meeting for the Town of Maple was called to order by Chairman Dustin Soyring at 7:00 pm at the Maple Community Center.

#### **ROLL CALL**

Chairman Dustin Soyring, Supervisor Jon TePoel, Treasurer Tanya Colby, Foreman Roger Colby, Fire Chief Mike Lundeen, Planning Commission Secretary Gaye Erkel, Planning Commission member Beverly Sidlo-Toliver and a handful of community members were in attendance. There being a quorum, the meeting was called to order.

#### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

#### TREASURER'S REPORT

#### **BRIEF PUBLIC COMMENT**

Gaye Erkel asked when the subscribe feature on the website might be working again. Treasurer Colby noted that the town's web developer is still troubleshooting the glitch. Erkel also noted that the Maple Cemetery Association has a new sexton and a mostly new board.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

1. County Supervisor

County Supervisor Loustari was not present to give a report.

# 2. Town Foreman

Foreman Colby noted that most grading and gravel hauling is wrapped up, though there are few soft spots due to rain. The pick-up truck is fixed with new filters and pumps installed; the work should eliminate injection issues.

The county is doing some logging on Dump Road - they've been encouraged to not use the blacktop; the town will earn some money from the proceeds.

The town will need to purchase a new air compressor - at least 60 psi - as the old one started smoking. Foreman Colby will look for a used one via consignment or auction.

# 3. Fire Department

The Department responded to 10 emergency calls this past month: Maple - 4 EMS and 1 alarm; Poplar - 3 EMS calls; Lake Nebagamon - 1 EMS and 1 Mutual Aid EMS call. The new Rescue truck has been delivered and trucks and equipment seem to be in good working order. Brule River Garage door has been at the station working on the northwest garage door. The opener was not working and the door requires adjustment. The office remodeling at the fire station continues. As always, folks interested in joining the department are encouraged to attend any of our Training or Meeting nights - the 3rd Wednesdays of the month and last Monday or Wednesday of the month. New members are always welcome!
